KJV Judges 8:32 And Gideon the son of Joash died in a good old age, and was buried in the sepulchre of Joash his father, in Ophrah of the Abiezrites. 33 And it came to pass, as soon as Gideon was dead, that the children of Israel turned again, and went a whoring after Baalim, and made Baalberith their god.

NRS Judges 9:22 Abimelech ruled over Israel **three years**.

KJV Judges 10:1 And after Abimelech there arose to defend Israel Tola the son of Puah, the son of Dodo, a man of Issachar; and he dwelt in Shamir in mount Ephraim. KJV Judges 10:2 And he judged Israel **twenty and three years**, and died, and was buried in Shamir. ("After" means "after"; there is no overlap).

Ammon takes most of the transjordan including Heshbon.

KJV Judges 10:3 And after him arose Jair, a Gileadite, and judged Israel **twenty and two years**. ("After" means "after"; there can be no overlap).

KJV Judges 11:26 While Israel dwelt in Heshbon and her towns, and in Aroer and her towns, and in all the cities that be along by the coasts of Arnon, **three hundred years**? why therefore did ye not recover them within that time? Jephthah is pointing to the time when Ammon reoccupied Heshbon in the transjordan. Jair and his cities escaped though until the death of Jair.
